

Dr. Rigas G. Giannopoulos is a graduate of the Law Faculty of the School of Legal, Economic and Political Sciences of Aristotle University Thessaloniki (1994).

He holds a postgraduate degree Magister Legum Europae (MLE) from the Law School of the University Hannover Germany (1996) obtained with the highest distinction (summacumlaude) and has been awarded with the PhD degree at the Law School of the Johann-Wolfgang Goethe Frankfurt am Main (2000) with the highest distinction (summacumlaude) following a 3year scholarship from the German Academic Exchange Service (DAAD). Since 2012 he is elected by the Law School of Aristotle University of Thessaloniki (AUTH) and works as a full time Assistant Professor at the Department of Commercial and Financial Law of the Law School of A.U.TH.

He teaches several courses of commercial and economic law at a graduate and postgraduate level, such as industrial property law, e-commerce law, banking law, consumer protection law and advanced course in general commercial law.

He is a member of the Bar Association of Thessaloniki since 1997 and an accredited mediator of the Greek Ministry of Justice and of ADRg. He also sits at the Legal Commission Department of the Aristotle University of Thessaloniki, and he is a member of various professional and scientific associations, such as the Commercial Law Experts' Association, the Macedonian Union of Commercial Law, the Union of former DAAD Scholars, the Association of German Speaking Lawyers in Northern Greece, Deutsch-Griechischer Juristenvereine.V., Verein Griechischer Akademiker Frankfurt am Main e.V. etc.

Dr. Giannopoulos has served as a member of several law drafting committees (Draft of Bankruptcy Code, Draft of Law no 3419/2005, Draft of Law no 3604/2007). He is currently appointed as the Training Coordinator at the Mediation Training Institute of Thessaloniki (a non profit organization set up under the rules of P.D. 123/2011 by the Bar Association of Thessaloniki, and all Chambers of Thessaloniki to provide mediation training). He sits at the National Committee of the European Association for Banking and Financial Law (EABFL) for Greece, and serves as a counsel of the Professional and Small - Medium Sized Industries Chamber of Thessaloniki on issues relating to Business Register. He has also been assigned to serve as a deputy supervisor of the liquidation of Insurance Companies, and has delivered training to experts and Slovak judges on European Company Law (in German and English) as part of the EU funded project "EUPhare Twinning Project Strengthening the Independence of the Judiciary (Reference no SR01/IB/JH/01, Slovakia 2002-2004).

He has participated in numerous scientific national and international conferences both as a main speaker and participant.
